> This Thursday, February 16th, at 6:30 PM, come to City Hall and City Council Chambers for an important meeting and comment session for our Fairhaven Neighborhood and Urban Village Plan (FNUVP). This will be an excellent opportunity to hear a staff presentation of the plan and where we are now, and then an opportunity to speak on the record, if you have any comments to make about the new proposals. Here is Nicole Oliver's exact wording on the meeting announcement from her email of Jan 23rd:
