Subject: Discussion regarding the Neighborhood Traffic Safety Program (NTSP)

Summary Statement: City Council requested a work session discussion regarding modifying the existing Neighborhood Traffic Safety Program (NTSP) to allow physical traffic calming on arterial streets. Arterial streets are intended to carry higher traffic volumes and provide primary access for emergency services and transit. In addition, traffic calming on arterials could result in the shifting of traffic to local streets. The NTSP is currently an unfunded program and due to ongoing budget constraints, staff will not be recommending reestablishing this program in 2014. Staff does not support modifying the NTSP and recommends pedestrian and bicycle conflicts be addressed through the implementation of the Pedestrian and Bicycle Master Plans using Transportation Benefit District funds.

Previous Council Action: Approved NTSP

Fiscal Impact: The NTSP is currently unfunded due to budget cuts in the Street Fund.
