Subject: Updates on Squalicum Creek Corridor Projects: Squalicum Creek Re-route (EV-110), James Street Bridge (ER-09), Orchard Street Extension (ES-0440), Bay to Baker Trail (PD3003-X)

Summary Statement: Staff will provide an update on projects within the Squalicum Creek corridor including the Squalicum Creek re-route, James Street Bridge, the Bay to Baker Trail, and future Orchard Street connector. These projects, currently at various stages of development, share a number of common facets, including the Squalicum Creek flood plain. Successful design and construction requires close inter-departmental coordination.

Previous Council Action: Approval of the Six-Year (2013-2018) Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) on 6/3/13; Approval of Resolution 2013-01 on 1/28/13; Previous Council updates on 1/28/13, 3/12/12, and 7/11/11.

Fiscal Impact: Squalicum Corridor Study is funded via \$400,000 from Street Funds and \$100,000 from Greenways 3; Squalicum Creek Re-route Phase 1 is funded via a \$1.7m grant/loan.

Funding Source: Department of Ecology, Surface and Stormwater Utility, Street Fund, Greenways 3
