Subject: An Ordinance increasing revenue and expenditures in the Wastewater Fund from the issuance of Revenue Bonds to pay for improvements to the wastewater system.

**Summary Statement:** On August 13, 2013, the City of Bellingham issued Water and Sewer Revenue Bonds through a competitive bid process. There were six bids received with William Blair & Company, LLC. being the low bidder. The funds were deposited into our account August 27, 2013 and will be used to improve the wastewater treatment plant.

**Previous Council Action:** Ordinance 2013-08-059 authorizing the issuance of Water and Sewer Revenue Bonds.

Fiscal Impact: The debt service for these bonds will be paid from the wastewater utility fund until 2043.

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AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE 2013 BUDGET INCREASING REVENUE IN THE WASTEWATER FUND FROM THE ISSUANCE OF REVENUE BONDS TO PAY FOR THE EXPANSION OF IMPROVEMENTS TO THE WASTEWATER SYSTEM AND APPROPRIATING \$16,039,500.45 IN RELATED EXPENDITURES.

**WHEREAS**, the City of Bellingham owns, operates, and maintains a combined water supply and distribution system and sewage collection and disposal system; and

WHEREAS, the system is in need of additions, betterments, and improvements; and

**WHEREAS**, the city is authorized pursuant to chapters 35.92 and 39.46 RCW to issue revenue bonds payable from operating revenues of the system for the purpose of financing costs of the project; and

WHEREAS, the Bonds were sold on August 13, 2013 by competitive bid.

### NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF BELLINGHAM DOES ORDAIN:

Revenue in the Wastewater Fund is hereby increased by \$16,039,500.45 as a result of issuing revenue bonds. The amount of \$16,039,500.45 is hereby appropriated to provide for the issuance costs associated with the bonds and construction of the system improvements. The source of funding will be credited from:
