**Subject:** Reclassification of the Resource Conservation Management Specialist Position to a Facilities Project Manager in the Public Works Operations Division

WHEREAS, the Public Works Department has requested an upgrade of a Program Specialist position in the Facilities Operations Group to provide for management of annual City-wide capital facilities projects, and					
WHEREAS, a new job classification of Project Manager has been created and the upgraded position has been allocated to the new classification, and					
WHEREAS, the Human Resources Department is proposing placement of the new classification in Salary Plan S, Grade 9 with a 5% market step, pending completion of negotiations of the final wage placement with the bargaining unit, and					
WHEREAS, no additional appropriation or reallocation of funds has been requested in order to accommodate the additional cost that results from placement of the upgraded position in the proposed salary plan and grade,					
NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF BELLINGHAM DOES ORDAIN:					
Effective October 1, 2013 one vacant position of Program Specialist, Plan S Grade 6, in the Public Works Facilities Operations Group, is hereby deleted. Effective October 1, 2013 one position of Project Manager, proposed in Plan S Grade 9 with a 5% market step, is hereby created. There is no change in FTEs as a result of this upgrade and no additional appropriation or reallocation of funds has been requested.
