

## Subject: Presentation regarding C-SPAN'S 2013 Cities Tour visit to Bellingham

**Summary Statement:** C-SPAN's 2013 Cities Tour takes its Book TV and American History TV programming on the road traveling to selected cities featuring the history and literary life of these communities. They choose cities rich with history and interesting local literary communities, not often featured on the national scene. They bring a little of the local heritage to their nationwide audience. Working Comcast, producers take specially outfitted Local Content Vehicles into the selected cities, visiting various literary and historic sites and interview local historians, authors and civic leaders The stories gathered by the video crew will later be shown on non-fiction book channel, Book TV and American History TV during C-SPAN's special Bellingham weekend January 4-5.

The event will feature a special presentation from local historian, author, and co-curator of Whatcom Museum's "Treasures from the Trunk: the Story of JJ Donovan", Brian Griffin, on the life of Donovan and his impact on the growth of Bellingham. This event, along with Q&A from the audience, will air with other local segments recorded throughout the week during the weekend of January 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup>on BookTV (on C-SPAN2) and American History TV (on C-SPAN3)

C-SPAN's 2013 Cities Tour takes our Book TV and American History TV (AHTV) programming on the road. We travel to selected cities to feature the history and literary life of these communities. We've chosen cities that are rich with history and have interesting local literary communities, but not often featured on the national scene. With our visit to each, we hope to bring a little of their heritage to our nationwide audience. Working with our cable partners, our producers will take our specially outfitted Local Content Vehicles (LCVs) into these selected cities, visiting various literary and historic sites, as we interview local historians, authors and civic leaders The stories gathered by the video crew will later be shown on nonfiction book channel Book TV (on C-SPAN2) and history channel American History TV (on C-SPAN3) during C-SPAN's special Bellingham weekend January 4-5.
