Subject: An Ordinance amending the 2014 budget appropriating \$2,250,000.00 in unanticipated grant revenue in the Street Fund for the Mahogany Avenue/Arctic Avenue Project

Summary Statement: Mahogany Avenue is situated north of Bakerview and will be an east-west multimodal collector arterial between Pacific Highway and Northwest Drive. Construction is scheduled for 2016 and will provide direct access to a new major economic development area in the City. Funding for this project includes (1) an award of a TIB grant in the amount of \$2,250,000.00 for the Mahogany Avenue/Arctic Avenue Project as well as (2) previous receipt of a federal grant in the amount of \$1,250,000.

Previous Council Action: Adoption of the 2014 Six-Year TIP

Fiscal Impact: Increase of revenue by \$2.25M

Funding Source: TIB, Federal Grant and Street Fund
