Subject: Resolution to Increase Fees and Charges at Bayview Cemetery

Summary Statement: The Cemetery is managed as an enterprise fund designed to have revenue cover expenses. Currently, the annual cost of maintenance and operations is \$566,758. This far exceeds revenue requiring a general fund subsidy of \$221,480. Over the last six years, staff positions have been eliminated and efficiencies have been implemented to reduce costs. However, more people are choosing cremation, which reduces revenue at the same time that the cost of labor, utilities and supplies to maintain the existing facilities has increased. An approximate 10% increase in fees will help offset these costs. The Parks and Recreation Department Advisory Board approved this recommendation on December 11, 2013.

Previous Council Action: Resolution 2011-27 increasing fees and charges for Bayview Cemetery

Fiscal Impact: An estimated \$27,000 will be generated in 2014 from the proposed increases.

Funding Source: Cemetery Fund

IV. NEW BUSINESS:

D. <u>2014 Bayview Cemetery Fee Increase</u>: Marvin Harris reported that staff are proposing an increase in Cemetery fees for 2014 and that they would like a Park Board recommendation on the fees before they go to City Council for approval. Marcia Wazny, Bayview Cemetery Sexton, said that the fee increases are needed to offset increased expenses. Marcia explained that Bayview Cemetery is an enterprise fund for the City that does not make enough revenue to cover expenses, and is subsidized by approximately \$200,000 from the City's General Fund. Staff just went to City Council earlier this week with a request for reserve funds to be appropriated to make up revenue shortfalls in 2013.

Marcia reported that Bayview Cemetery's fees have not been increased in two years. In order to come up with the proposed 2014 prices, Marcia surveyed 50+ other cemeteries in the state of Washington to see how their prices compare to Bayview's and learned that Bayview's current rates fall on the low end.

Matt Randall asked what the largest operational cost was at Bayview Cemetery. Marvin Harris responded that it is maintenance. There are many historic grave sites from years prior to an endowed care charge being instituted and maintaining them all is a large burden on the budget. Mike Anderson asked if the fee increases will balance Bayview Cemetery's budget in 2014. Marcia Wazny responded that it will help, but she cannot accurately predict whether or not the budget will be balanced. Marcia stated that 70% of people who pass away in Whatcom County are cremated, which is following a national trend of increased cremation nationwide. Cremation is cheaper than burial and ashes may be spread rather than deposited in a cemetery. Marcia said that they are looking at other ways to reduce their costs to balance their budget. Marcia reported that she recently completed a report on Bayview Cemetery that includes the budget's history, challenges and ideas for the future. James King said that he anticipates that in the future, the City Council will be asked to increase the General Fund subsidy to balance Bayview's budget. The report completed by Marcia is being reviewed by staff and will be shared with the Park Board as the 2015 Parks Department budget request is put together.

Dominique Zervas moved to recommend approval of the 2014 proposed Bayview Cemetery price list as submitted. Matt Randall seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously.
