Staff and the applicant held a neighborhood meeting in 2020 where no concerns were identified.

Additionally, staff held a two week public comment period and a notice of public hearing and additionally no concerns were identified from the public. There is a public hearing this evening with the hearing examiner either in person at City Hall in the Council Chambers at 6:00 PM or virtually at the link below which is the last opportunity to provide public comment regarding the proposed development.
