Project Name: Northwest Drive Infill Toolkit Townhouse Development

**Project Description:** Development of 34 infill toolkit townhouses and retention of an existing single family residence subdivided on fee simple lots through a cluster preliminary plat. All townhouses will be 3-stories in a combination of 4-unit, 5-unit and 6-unit buildings. Access will be provided from a new private driveway/lane off Northwest Ave. On-site parking will be provided for the townhouses within two car garages, driveways and guest parking provided off the newly constructed driveway. Private pedestrian pathways will be provided throughout the site including a connection to Talus Way. No direct or indirect wetland impacts are proposed, however limited wetland buffer reductions are proposed and will be mitigated through buffer enhancement and restoration. Approximately, 2,402 sq ft of buffer impact is proposed. Frontage improvements will be provided along Northwest Ave. abutting the property with a new curb, gutter and sidewalk.
