## **NOTICE OF HYBRID PUBLIC HEARING**

The City of Bellingham Hearing Examiner will hold an **in-person** and **virtual Zoom** public hearing at **6:00 p.m**. on **Wednesday, November 13, 2024,** in City Council Chambers, City Hall, 210 Lottie Street, to take testimony on the following proposal:

SUB2024-0016: Request to develop 34 Infill Toolkit townhouses and retention of the existing single-family residence subdivided on fee simple lots through a Cluster Preliminary Plat. All townhouses will be three-stories in a combination of four-unit, fiveunit and six-unit buildings. Access will be provided from a new private driveway/lane off Northwest Avenue. On-site parking will be provided for the townhouses within two car garages, driveways and guest parking provided off the newly constructed driveway. Private pedestrian pathways will be provided throughout the site including a connection to Talus Way. No direct or indirect wetland impacts are proposed however limited wetland buffer reductions are proposed and will be mitigated through buffer enhancement and restoration. Frontage improvements will be provided along Northwest Avenue abutting the property with a new curb, gutter and sidewalk. The proposal is located at 4241 Northwest Avenue, and legally described as AM Canfield's 3<sup>rd</sup> Add To Whatcom Lots 5 Thru 8-15 Blk 1-Exc Ptn To City Of Bellingham For Street Desc Af 2017-0800073. Residential Single zoning, Detached, Cluster Attached and Detached, Mixed with Cluster use qualifier with Infill Toolkits as an allowed use. Ali Taysi, AVT Consulting, applicant; Chay and Christian Tan & Ethan and Kelli Potts, owners. Cordata Neighborhood, Area 20.
