Likely here. We would only tap the DI for a new hydrant.



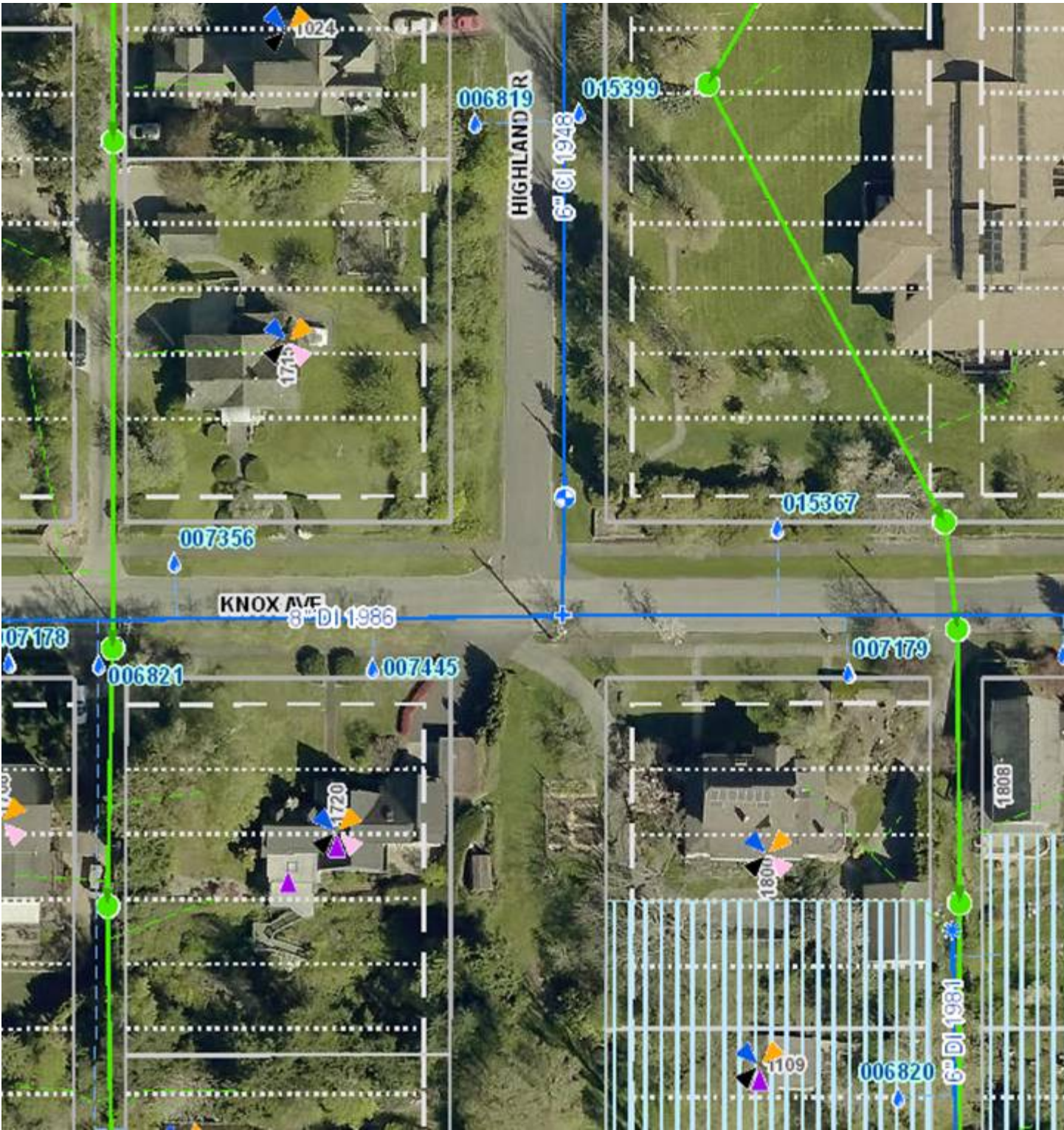
