The City of Bellingham Pro Tem Hearing Examiner will hold an in-person and virtual Zoom public hearing to take testimony on the following proposal:

- 1. <u>VAR2024-0001</u>: A variance request to allow a short-term rental (STR) in an existing detached accessory dwelling unit (DADU) which is not the primary residence of the property owner or a long-term renter. The applicant is requesting a variance from the following Bellingham Municipal Code (BMC) sections:
 - BMC 20.10.037.B.5.c., which prohibits STRs in DADUs in residential single general use type areas.
 - BMC 20.10.037.C.1 and BMC 20.10.37.D.3, which requires the subject dwelling unit (DADU) must serve as the primary residence of the applicant (the owner or long-term tenant) for no less than 270 days per year. The whole dwelling unit may be rented for no more than 95 days per year.

The project is located at 1017 Liberty Street, Unit 101 and legally described as Eldrige-Bartlett's Add to Sehome Lot 21 Blk 18 – subj to Boundary Line Agreement Rec AF 2024-0400180.

J. Patrick and Kathryn Sutton, owners/applicants. Residential Single, Detached, with a 6,875 sq. ft. minimum detached lot size land use designation. Sehome Neighborhood, Area 11.

You may also request a copy of the Hearing Examiner's decision and your appeal rights.
