Notice is hereby given that the Planning and Community Development Department (PCDD) has received an application for a **design review permit and SEPA environmental review** for the following project:

Project Name: Whatcomm 911 Call Center

Project Description: Proposed construction of a new approximately 8,000 square foot (sf), single story, 911 dispatch center ("Whatcomm") with staff parking lot and landscaped areas. Construction of the new building is proposed to occur while the existing dispatch center remains operational to prevent a lapse in public safety service. Demolition of the existing building is proposed once the new building is functioning. The Washington State Department of Archaeology and Historic Preservation (DAHP) determined that the existing building proposed for demolition is not eligible for listing on a historic register nor is it contributing to a historic district (Project 2024-03-01782).

Commercial design review is required per BMC 20.25.020(E)(2) because the scope is development of an office building. SEPA environmental review is required per BMC 16.20.090(D) because the building is larger than 5,000 sf.

Project Location: 2425 Iron Street. Area 9 of the Sunnyland Neighborhood, zoned Public Governmental services.
