Notice is hereby given that the City of Bellingham Design Review Board (DRB) will hold an Early Design Guidance Meeting on **April 15, 2025, at 3:00 P.M**. This meeting will be held in person and via zoom. In person will be held at 210 Lottie Street, City Council Chambers, Bellingham, WA. Instructions to participate via Zoom are included with this notice.

Meeting Purpose: The early design guidance meeting provides early guidance from the DRB to a project proponent for projects that are in the conceptual stage. The applicant(s) presents the project to the DRB and discusses the project and how it meets the urban village design guidelines and standards. The applicant will present the project concept (general site plan, neighborhood character and mass/bulk studies) to the DRB, describing the design approach and any alternative concepts or requested departures. The DRB will review public comment, deliberate, and provide direction on information to be included with the design review application. Public comment relevant to the application of the design criteria will be considered, but the DRB may restrict the time allotted for comment to complete its meeting agenda.

Proposed Project: Proposed construction of a 31-unit multifamily building. The proposed building is configured with vehicular access off Rose Street into a structured parking garage and live-work space lining N State Street. Four (4) stories of apartments are proposed over this base with the fourth story having loft areas. Two (2) existing buildings are proposed to be removed to accommodate the proposed development. An Early Design Guidance meeting is required because the project is in the Downtown Urban Village design review district (BMC 20.25.020(C)(1)). Street improvements to Rose Street and N State Street will be completed as a part of the project scope.
