NOTICE OF DECISION

PDP2025-0004

The City of Bellingham has approved a **Planned Development Permit** for the proposed project listed below on April 4, 2025.

Project Description: Proposal to remove all four (4) properties from an existing Planned Contract #93-09 (AF 940428147) and establish a new Planned Development Permit to govern the properties consistent with underlying zoning and current development regulations.

A similar permit (PDP2024-0002) was approved March 11, 2024, to remove three (3) properties from the Planned Contract, 3236, 3240, and 3300 Northwest Avenue. This permit has been withdrawn so that the fourth property, 3250 Northwest Avenue, may also be included in this new Planned Development Permit application.

Project Location: 3236, 3240, 3250, and 3300 Northwest Avenue. Birchwood Area 10, zoned Planned Commercial, density not specified.

Any property owner who believes they are affected by this decision may request a change in valuation for property tax purposes, notwithstanding any program of revaluation, through the Whatcom County Assessor's office.
