
#### What is the PROS Plan?

- Review of Park Impact Fees
- Regional coordination w/BSD, Port, Ferndale, Whatcom, and Lummi
- Review facility standards trails and pocket parks
- Integration of Waterfront Subarea Plan
- Operations Chapter standards for maintenance
- Parallel update of Greenways Strategic Plan
