Guidance / Response Meeting Continued from October 4th, 2022

PRE2022-0075: Proposed development of the vacant property generally located between 10th and 11th Streets and between Mill and Knox Avenues, with basement garage parking, first floor commercial and residential above. The project proposes two design options for the site. Design option one proposes approximately 14,965 square feet (sf) of commercial floor area and 110,735 square feet of residential floor area (106 units) in one large building. Design option two proposes approximately 14,520 sf of commercial floor area and 116,567 sf of residential floor area (153 units) in four smaller buildings and a public plaza with pedestrian pathways. Both design options propose 255 parking stalls beneath. The proposals include a separate residential building located at 1100 10th Street with approximately 27,958 sf of residential floor area (27 units), and a 15-stall basement parking garage and three on-grade stalls accessed from 10th Street. 11th Street abutting the site will be improved with on-street parking and sidewalk. Design Review is required because the project is in the Fairhaven design review district.
